SENIOR ACTIVITIES May 31-June 5, 2019

We will be taking both group and individual graduation pictures on Monday, June 3, 2019 so make sure you wear your cap and gown. The group picture is approximately \$20.00 and individual picture packages are also available and purchasing information will be handed out the week prior to graduation. **The deadline to purchase senior group and/or individual pictures will be Tuesday, June 11.** No orders will be accepted after that date so please plan ahead. Please make checks payable to LifeTouch Photography. Pictures will be mailed to your home after graduation if they have been paid for in advance.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Graduation practice is mandatory all days if you plan to participate in the graduation ceremony!



SPECIAL NOTE: We need and expect complete cooperation from each and every senior throughout this period of final activities planned with and for you. Some students in previous years have caused themselves to be excluded from graduation because they could not conduct themselves in terms of acceptable behavior. The use of alcohol, drugs and all forms of undesirable conduct by students can result in removal from graduation exercises. All school rules apply. We want each senior to realize this now in order that the senior week may be a pleasant experience. The assistance and cooperation of every student and parent is appreciated.

DISNEYLAND GRAD NITE Wednesday, June 5, 2019

Disneyland Grad Nite is a once-in-a-lifetime experience where you and your friends get to create one final high school memory. In 2019 you will have a park hopper ticket to both Disneyland and California Adventures and then attend graduates only party in California Adventures from 9 pm - 2 am. This will include the rides, attractions, and the dance parties exclusive to Grad Nite. Hang out with friends at this once-in-a-lifetime experience. Buses will leave Wednesday from Sierra Street promptly at **10:00 P.M.** and should arrive back in Kingsburg about **6:00 A.M.** on Thursday. Students should board the bus by **9:30 P.M. NO LATER!**

Dress Code: Kingsburg High dress code will be enforced with the following additions and/or reminders:

- Clothing not in good repair will be allowed (tears, holes, ragged hems, etc.)
- Denim may be worn if it is not "distressed" and is in good repair.
- Boys and girls: shorts that are at least knee-length may be worn.
- No weapons of any kind or laser pointers
- No food or beverages (including water, snacks, gum, mints)
- No alcohol, tobacco products or controlled substances.
- No aerosol or glass cans/bottles.
- Medication (both over the counter and prescription) must be in it's original container with the student name clearly identified on the container and may be carried by the student. Please notify chaperone that you are carrying medication. Students may carry inhalers. Please see Mrs. Lund for special circumstances.



The cost is \$205 per student. The price includes transportation by charter bus, admission to Disneyland and California Adventures and a dinner/snack bag for on the bus.

SENIORS ARE TO REPORT TO THE NEW GYM AT 7:00 P.M. TO CHECK IN.

Girls are to wear a dress or a skirt and blouse ensemble or a nice pants outfit with dress shoes or dress sandals. Boys are to wear collared shirts with or without a tie and nice slacks with nice dress shoes. This is an important time in your life so please dress accordingly. All graduating seniors should wear a gown and a cap with the tassel on the left.

*In fairness to our entire community there will be **NO** reserved seating. All blankets in the stadium will be removed prior to 6:00 P.M. The gates will be unlocked at 6:00 P.M. Parents and families are advised to arrive early to enjoy the concert by the Viking Band, which will begin at 7:00 P.M.*

We would like to suggest that you have your pictures taken during the week preceding commencement since you will have your cap and gown. Only limited opportunities for picture taking is available at graduation. A professional photographer will take cap and gown pictures of each individual on Monday, June 3, 2019. We ask that no individual pictures be taken during the graduation ceremony.



As a courtesy to other families and spectators, please leave balloons and signs that you may have brought for your graduate in the car so that they won't obstruct the view of others. If you bring them in you will be asked to leave them at the gate before entering graduation.
