Return all applications to KHS Counseling or CCC unless indicated otherwise on application.

WATCH DUE DATES

Aved P. Shagoian Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

The applicant must be planning to go to college and major in music. A \$350 scholarship is offered.

Bob Koch Athletic Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

This is for students who have participated in sports and who are planning to further their education after high school.

Brian Jones Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

The applicant must be accepted to the college or vocational school of his/her choice for the fall term immediately after graduation and intend to pursue a career in Agriculture. Applicants who have been awarded a full scholarship to an institution (which includes tuition, fees, room and board) from any other source, or sources, will not be eligible to accept this scholarship. The applicant would have the opportunity to participate in a paid summer internship in agriculture.

Clay Elementary School Scholarship

Deadline: April 26th- return to counseling or CCC

Student must have graduated from Clay Elementary, and have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. All recipients must enroll in school prior to the spring semester of the year following high school graduation or forfeit the scholarship. Proof of college registration is required.

Dennis W. Jones Memorial Scholarship -“The Stump Award”

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

Dennis was a KHS 1964 graduate. This offers an award of \$500 to a student athlete with an interest in football. The recipient of this award must have the three qualities that the game of football taught Dennis: hard work, the meaning of the word team, and the importance of good friendship.

Gladys Curtis Cosmetology Scholarship

Deadline: May 1- return to Counseling or CCC

Graduating senior planning to attend a school of Cosmetology

Hazel and Marvin Morine Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: March 26th- - mail to address specified

Criteria for this scholarship: Attend a four-year college or university, be of high moral character and ethics, preference shall be given, but not restricted to a person planning to attend a Christian college, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, transcript and two letters of recommendation.

Hillblom Vocational Grant**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

This application is for a student who is planning to attend an eligible community college or technical school accredited by a U.S. Department of Education approved agency. It is also defined as a two-year or less vocational/technical program, culminating in an associate degree (not a stepping stone to a bachelor's degree), diploma, or certificate, but less than a bachelor's degree. Student will be selected on academic strength, motivation, intent to complete post-secondary education and financial profile. Awards are up to a maximum of \$7,500.

Holy Family Council 9213 Knights of Columbus Scholarship**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

Applicant must be accepted to the college or vocational school of their choice for the fall term after graduation. Applicant will be evaluated on GPA, financial need, citizenship, school leadership and involvement in clubs, sports, etc.

Juan & Elena Cuenca College Scholarship**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

This scholarship is for a student with an interest in business, engineering, or biology. Student must be planning to attend post-secondary in the fall, be of Hispanic descent, and show need for financial assistance.

Katie Trevino Memorial**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

Applicant must be a Kingsburg High graduate and have plans to enroll in a 4 year college or university in the fall following graduation from high school. Preference will be given to a student planning to attend UC and major in the field of creative writing or communications, but other college choices or majors will be considered.

KHS Volleyball Boosters Scholarship**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

This scholarship is limited to girls. Girls must have participated in the KHS volleyball program for at least 3 years including the senior year. Students must also have been accepted to a post-secondary institution.

Kings River Scholarship**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

Applicants must have graduated from Kings River School and have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. All recipients must enroll in school prior to the spring semester of the year following graduation or forfeit the scholarship.

Kingsburg Catholic Women Club Scholarship**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

Applicant must be an active member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Kingsburg, attend Sunday mass weekly and keep all church precepts. Must have been involved in confirmation/Life Teen program and be accepted to a college or vocational school of their choice as a fulltime student.

Kingsburg Community Assistance Programs Scholarship**Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC**

The application requires a written statement of educational and personal goals, and need for a scholarship. A current financial statement must also be provided.

Kingsburg Fine Arts

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

This scholarship is designed and intended for a graduating senior from Kingsburg High School, who will be pursuing post-secondary education in the fine arts.

Kingsburg Girls Softball Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

Citizenship, school involvement, GPA, and financial need are considered.

Applicant must have played softball, maintained a good GPA, have plans to attend college and have parents who have participated in the softball program.

Kingsburg Gun Club

Deadline: May 1st- return to Counseling or CCC

A graduating senior that has a parent that belongs to the Kingsburg Gun Club or student has worked at the Gun in the last two years.

Kingsburg High Agriculture Boosters Scholarship

Deadline: April 15th– online application- google forms

Application will explain criteria and award amounts

Kingsburg High Aquatic Boosters Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

Applicants must have completed at least 3 seasons of any Aquatic Sport (swimming, diving, water polo- one during the senior year) and be graduating with at least a 2.5 GPA.

Kingsburg High Associated Student Body Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

This is for those students who have held student body class offices or club offices. A short statement of activities in school that helped to promote school spirit or made a difference in your school is required.

Kingsburg High Boys Basketball Boosters

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

This scholarship is limited to seniors that have participated in the KHS basketball program. The applicant must have applied and been accepted to a post-secondary institution.

Kingsburg High School California Scholarship Federation

Deadline: May 1st- return to counseling or CCC

This scholarship is for students who have been a paid member of the KHS CSF chapter for at least one semester during their senior year.

Kingsburg High Softball Boosters Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

This is for students who played high school softball at KHS.

Kingsburg High Teacher's Association Teacher Candidate Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

The application requires current GPA, goals in wanting to become a teacher, and a listing of club and organization membership or leadership.

Kingsburg Maker Scholarship

Deadline May 1st- return to Counseling or CCC

A senior graduating from KHS, intending to attend a post-secondary institution. There is no GPA requirement but student displays a love and dedication to the creative arts. Student must supply a copy of a creative project

Kingsburg Professional Firefighters Association

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must be planning to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school to pursue a career in Fire, EMS. It is also open to students that have a relative that is actively employed as a firefighter or EMS

Kingsburg Youth Soccer League Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

The applicant must have participated in the Kingsburg Youth Soccer program and also must have participated in varsity soccer during his/her senior year. Awards of \$200 are given to one female and one male.

Larry Hillblom Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

Applicant must be accepted to the college of his/her choice for the fall term after graduation and be in the top 15% of their graduating class. Those who have already been awarded a full scholarship to an institution from any other source will not be eligible to accept this scholarship award. Also required is a personal autobiographical statement, which also states your reason for applying for this scholarship.

Rafer Johnson Junior High School Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

The Olympian Parent Club is offering a scholarship for a student that has been promoted from RJJH to Kingsburg High School. The student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5, enroll in a post-secondary college or technical/vocational school, complete the application and write an essay.

Rose Gong Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must have had an immediate family member who has had cancer. The applicant must also be planning to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school. .

Shiv Singh Purewal Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: May 1st return to Counseling or CCC

Applicant must be graduating with their class at KHS, submit two letters of recommendation, be accepted to a 4 year college or university, submit the application and personal statement.

Selma Masonic Lodge

Deadline: April 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

The requirements for this scholarship are to write a one-page essay on the Masonic Lodge. Tell about a person, place, event, or personal experience which involves the Masons.

Selma Trex Fraternity

Deadline: April 1st-- - mail to address provided or complete electronically

The Selma chapter is offering five \$1,000 scholarships to deserving seniors for the 2020-21 school year.

Consideration in selection is as follows: A student of Armenian descent. (List parent or parents) who are of Armenian descent and their Armenian family name); Financial need; Promise and intent of student to pursue a college education; Currently enrolled as a senior at a high school located in Fresno, Kings or Madera County Evaluation of applicant's personal information sheet, and letter of recommendation submitted by the principal, dean or counselor.

Seth Costas Memorial

Deadline- April 30th-- return to Counseling or CCC

Applicant is asked basic information and to write an essay on how they have made a difference in someone's life, and their plans for the future.

Tague Jones Memorial Science Scholarship

Deadline: May 1- return to Counseling or CCC

Tague Jones was a 2012 graduate of Kingsburg High. He had a passion for science and his family would like to support anyone with a similar passion. To be eligible, the applicant must have an interest in Physics and/or other science; no GPA requirement but must be slated for graduation.

Tri-County Family Medical Clinic Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

This scholarship requires information on GPA and academic interests.

Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 6152 Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

Applicant must have a family relative who is a veteran and provide a statement regarding educational and personal goals and need for a scholarship.

Weston Anderson Science Scholarship

Deadline: May 1 – return to Counseling or CCC

Applicant must be accepted to the college of his/her choice (2 or 4 year) for the fall term immediately following graduation, plan to major in the science/medical field, and be in the top 20% of his/her graduating class.

William Lee Tucker Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: June 1st mail to address provided

Applicant must be a graduate or receive a GED from Kingsburg High School District. Planning to attend a post-secondary college or non-profit vocational or technical institution in the fall of 2021. They are looking for a student that has determination and strong commitment to succeed in their post-secondary endeavor.
